On Thursday, July 12 at 8:30 we are hosting and AARP Smart Driver course. The class includes research based safe driving strategies; information on the effects of medication while driving; preventative measures to reduce driver distraction; proper use of technology found in newer vehicles; techniques for handling left turns, right of ways, and roundabouts; and state specific rules and regulations for key areas, such as construction zones, child safety seats, school bus zones, cellphone use, and more.
