Big Lies in a Small Town

by Diane Chamberlain

Chamberlain's plot moves back and forth from present to the 1940's, weaving the story of a young woman from each era. Their lives are affected by a (real life) federal competition that was held in the 40's to place a mural in one post office in each of the United States.
